**KURIOS****Mark 6:1-13 | February 11**

Journal it. Ask a friend. Discuss it in a group.

Reflect | Can you think of a time when someone you've known for a really long time surprised you? What did they do? What did it teach you about them?

Excavate | What do the miracles performed by Jesus so far in Mark's Gospel say about him? How do these miracles contrast with the features of Jesus' earthly life noted in the narrative (e.g. birth, family, etc.)?

Interpret | What do you think it means that Jesus is sovereign over the chaos of the cosmos, the world, human life, and even diseases and evil spirits but also somehow not able to do miracles in his hometown?

Examine | In what ways does familiarity with Christ, the Gospel, and life in a religious community impede the power of the Gospel in our own lives?

Apply | Spend some time reflecting on this passage, perhaps reading it daily for the next week. Note the words, phrases, and questions that surprise you each time you read with a fresh insight about Jesus.

Invite | Jesus sends out the twelve to preemptively bring healing and restoration in the places where he was about to go. Who is Jesus sending you to love and serve as preparation for the Gospel?
