#### **Sunday Morning Ministries**

#### Infants & Toddlers | Emily Rosendahl | erosendahl@fellowshipreformed.org

Nursery is offered for infants through 3 years old during the 9am and 10:30am worship services. It is open 15 minutes before and 10 minutes after each service. Nursery is staffed by Emily, our Nursery Coordinator, and/or a high school attendant, along with parents who make use of the Nursery.

#### Children Age 3 (by September 1) - 5th Grade

Children begin worship in the Sanctuary with their families and are dismissed before the sermon. They will then line up in the Atrium and follow their teachers to their classroom. Pick up your child in the Children's Wing following the service.

CHILDREN & WORSHIP Offered only @ 10:30am for kids 3 years old through 1st grade. These kids worship in their own space called "The Worship Center". They hear stories of God, sing songs, have work time to respond, listen to scripture, and have a time of sharing and prayer.

SUNDAY SCHOOL Offered @ 9am and 10:30am for kids 3-years-old through 5th grade. Kids learn about God's story and how they fit into it. At 9am, kids will be together in one class. At 10:30am, kids will be split into 2nd/3rd and 4th/5th grades. Our "Living the Word" curriculum follows the same scripture and theme that we do in the Sanctuary.

#### Child Check-In

Please check your child in at the Check-In Kiosk in the Atrium before the start of the service. Keep your parent pick-up tag to show your child's teacher. This is for infants - 5th grade.

#### **All Together Sundays**

A time for children in 2nd-8th grades to remain with their families for the entire worship service. There is no regular Sunday School on those Sundays. The dates for this fall are November 27, December 25, and January 1. Nursery and Children & Worship is still offered for children through 1st grade on these Sundays.
